

L.N. 155 of 2005**PRODUCT SAFETY ACT
(ACT NO. V OF 2001)****Cosmetic Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2005**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 39 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister for Competitiveness and Communications has, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, made the following regulations:–

1. (1) The title of these regulations is the Cosmetic Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2005, and they shall be read and construed as one with the Cosmetic Products Regulations, 2004 hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”. Citation and scope. L.N. 424 of 2004.

(2) These regulations implement the provisions of Commission Directive 2005/9/EC of the 29th January, 2005.

3. In the Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations, immediately after Reference No. 27 there shall be added Reference No. 28 as follows: Amends the Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations.
