

## L.N. 295 of 2005

**PRODUCT SAFETY ACT  
(ACT NO. V OF 2001)**

**Cosmetic Products (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2005**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 39 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister for Competitiveness and Communications has, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, made the following regulations:-

**1.** The title of these regulations is the Cosmetic Products (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 2005, and they shall be read and construed as one with the Cosmetic Products Regulations, 2004 hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”. Citation and coming into force. L.N. 424 of 2004.

**2.** These regulations implement the provisions of Commission Directive 2005/42/EC of the 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2005.

**3.** As from the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2005, cosmetic products that fail to comply with the provisions of the these regulations shall not be placed on the market by manufacturers or importers.

**4.** In the Second Schedule to the principal regulations, there shall be added the following reference numbers: - Amends the Second Schedule to the principal regulations.

“1133. Costus root oil (*Saussurea lappa Clarke*) (CAS No 8023-88-9), when used as a fragrance ingredient

1134. 7-Ethoxy-4-methylcoumarin (CAS No 87-05-8), when used as a fragrance ingredient

1135. Hexahydrocoumarin (CAS No 700-82-3), when used as a fragrance ingredient

1136. Peru balsam (INCI name: Myroxylon pereirae; CAS No 8007-00-9), when used as a fragrance ingredient”.

Amends the Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations.

5. In the Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations, in Part 1 thereof, the colouring agents “CI 12150”, “CI 20170” and “CI 27290” shall be deleted.

Amends the Fifth Schedule to the principal regulations.

6. In the Fifth Schedule to the principal regulations, in Part 1 thereof, for reference number 53 there shall be substituted by the following:-

7. In the Fifth Schedule to the principal regulations, in Part 1 thereof, there shall be added the following reference number 57:-
