

L.N. 391 of 2010**PRODUCT SAFETY ACT
(CAP. 427)****Cosmetic Products (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2010**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 39 of the Product Safety Act, the Prime Minister has, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, made the following regulations:-

1. The title of these regulations is the Cosmetic Products (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2010, and they shall be read and construed as one with the Cosmetic Products Regulations, 2004, hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”.

2. (1) Reference number 207 of regulation 3(a) and regulation 4 of these regulations shall apply as from 1st March, 2011. These regulations implement the provisions of Commission Directive 2010/3/EU of 1 February 2010 amending, for the purpose of adaptation to technical progress, Annexes III and VI to Council Directive 76/768/EEC concerning cosmetic products.

Commencement and scope.

(2) Reference numbers 208 and 209 of regulation 3(a) and regulation 3(b) of these regulations, except the obligations concerning the labelling set out in column (f) of reference number 208, shall apply as from 1st December, 2010. This regulation implements the provisions of Commission Directive 2010/4/EU of 8 February 2010 amending, for the purpose of adaptation to technical progress, Annex III to Council Directive 76/768/EEC concerning cosmetic products.


(3) After 1st November 2011 no cosmetic products which fail to comply with the obligations concerning the labelling set out in column (f) of reference number 208 of regulation 3(a) of these regulations shall be placed on the market. After 1st November 2012 no cosmetic products which fail to comply with the obligations concerning the labelling set out in column (f) of

reference number 208 of regulation 3(a) of these regulations, shall be sold or disposed of to the final consumer.

Amends the Third
Schedule to the
principal regulations.

3. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations shall be amended as follows:

(a) In the table set out in Part 1, the following reference numbers 207, 208 and 209 shall be inserted immediately after reference number 206:
